Game Overview

The Missouri State Lady Bears tip off their 48th season of varsity competition on the road Friday with a 7 p.m. game at Memphis. Missouri State is coming off a 24-10 season that ended in the school's 14th NCAA Tournament appearance, and is picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference this year.

The Lady Bears won their two exhibition contests at JQH Arena by an average score of 79.5-54, and will spend plenty of time on the road in November, with visits to Memphis (Nov. 11), Kansas (Nov. 13), Northwestern (Nov. 16) and the Great Alaska Shootout (Nov. 22-23) before opening the home schedule with Little Rock on Nov. 28.

Series History

Missouri State is 1-2 against Memphis, with two meetings in the last five seasons and another in 1980. The Lady Bears defeated the Tigers by an 82-65 final in the first round of the 2012 WNIT at JQH Arena, and Memphis grabbed a 79-63 victory in the 2014-15 season opener in Memphis.

Scouting Memphis

Memphis is predicted to finish seventh in the American Athletic Conference this season after going 18-13 overall last year and finished fourth in the AAC on the way to a WNIT appearance. The Tigers lost their lone exhibition contest, 52-44 to Lee University. Cheyenne Creighton is the Memphis' top returning scorer at 6.6 points per game on .592 shooting. Ninth-year head coach Melissa McFerrin is a native of Cassville, Mo.

Scouting the Lady Bears

Missouri State has a new look in 2016-17, but still boasts plenty of talent on a seasoned roster with championship experience. Junior guard Liza Fruendt is MSU's leading returning scorer after averaging 11.0 points and knocking down 59 3-pointers last season, and senior Lexi Hughes has made 120 treys in her career and led the Missouri Valley Conference in 3-point accuracy in 2014. MSU's four returning post players have combined for 285 career games and 72 starts entering the year, while the team's lone sophomore, Danielle Gitzen, made 19 starts as a true freshman. Missouri State also features a talented freshman class that includes Brice Calip, Shameka Ealy, Emily Gartner and Alexa Willard.

Exhibition Recap

Missouri State picked up a pair of exhibition wins, defeating Truman State by a 72-62 score and Northeastern State by an 87-46 margin at JQH Arena. The Lady Bears shot 51.3 percent from long range in the two games, led by Lee Ann Polowy's 8-for-10 performance, and owned a 49-24 average rebounding margin. Polowy averaged 13 points per game, and junior Liza Fruendt led MSU in scoring with a 15.5 average. Seven different players scored at least 5.5 points per game, and Rachel Swartz averaged a team-high 9.5 rebounds.

For Openers

The Lady Bears are 22-25 all time in season openers following last season's 71-55 loss to Missouri. MSU has lost 10 of its last 12 openers.

Quick Hits

- Missouri State has ranked among the MVC's top three in total rebounds, offensive rebounds and rebounding margin for six consecutive seasons.
- Missouri State became the 35th Division I team to reach 800 victories on Jan. 15, 2016, and entered the 2016-17 campaign ranked 33rd on the all-time wins list.
- Missouri State has finished fourth or better in the MVC standings 18 times in 24 seasons in the league.
- MSU is 14-4 in its last 18 road games, dating to Feb. 20, 2015, a stretch that included 10 consecutive MVC road wins and the best 14-game run (13-1) in school history.
- Missouri State has made at least 10 free throws 107 of its last 127 games. The Lady Bears made nearly has many foul shots (491) as opponents attempted (520) in 2015-16.
- MSU is 51-21 (.708) at home since the beginning of the 2011-12 season, averaging 73.3 points in those 72 games while topping the 70-point mark 47 times and scoring 80 or more 24 times.
- The Lady Bears are 39-5 under Harper when scoring at least 70 points.
- MSU is 48-0 under Harper when leading with 5:00 left on the game clock, and 50-1 when holding a lead with two minutes remaining, with the loss coming at Loyola on Jan. 12, 2014. In fact, the Lady Bears have won 87 consecutive games in which they led when the game clock surpassed the five-minute mark, the last loss coming to Bradley on Feb. 4, 2011.

Head Coach Kellie Harper

Kellie Harper is 56-42 in her fourth season at Missouri State and holds a 223-171 career record in her 12th season as a head coach, including four NCAA Tournament appearances and five WNIT berths in that span. She earned her 200th career coaching victory on Nov. 17, 2015 against MidAmerica Nazarene.

Her teams have historically played their best in the postseason, as she holds a collective 28-17 record in conference tournaments, NCAA Tournaments, and WNIT games. In fact, in 21 seasons as a Division I head coach, assistant coach and player, Harper has made 17 postseason appearances with a combined 471-224 (.678) record, 12 NCAA Tournament appearances and five WNIT bids.

Harper was the head coach at North Carolina State from 2009-2013, directing the Wolfpack to three postseason appearances during her four years at the helm, including the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

Prior to her stint in Raleigh, Harper piloted Western Carolina to a 97-65 record and four postseason berths in five seasons, including a 70-31 mark her final three seasons in Cullowhee as the Catamounts captured the first two Southern Conference Tournament titles in school history.

The former Kellie Jolly played on three national championship clubs at Tennessee for the legendary Pat Summitt and earned honorable mention All-America honors as a senior in 1999.

Harper and her husband Jon, who has served as an assistant on her coaching staff at Western Carolina, NC State, and now at Missouri State, welcomed their first child, Jackson, in November 2013.

2015-16 In Review

Missouri State won the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and made the school's 14th NCAA appearance in 2015-16, finishing 24-10 overall and tying for second in the MVC with a 14-4 league mark. The Lady Bears went 15-2 in their 17 games leading up to an NCAA loss at fourth-seeded Texas A&M, including a stretch of holding five consecutive opponents below 50 points as defense became a calling card of the team.

MSU featured one of the top senior classes in school history, with Kenzie Williams and Tyonna Snow each finishing their careers among the school's top 10 scorers. Williams was a two-time first-team all-MVC pick, while Snow became the third player in league history to be named Jackie Stiles Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in the same season. She left MSU with four school records, including steals in a season and career.

Liza Fruendt ranked third on MSU in scoring at 11 points per game to become the ninth player in school history to average double figures as a freshman and sophomore, and Lexi Hughes joined her as two of the 15 Lady Bears to make 100 career 3-pointers.

High Scoring Staff

The 2015-16 Lady Bear coaching staff combined to score 5,087 points at the Division I level during their playing careers with four All-America seasons, four Final Four appear-

ances and three national championships.

Head Coach Kellie (Jolly) Harper won three national titles at Tennessee under the legendary Pat Summitt, including a 39-0 junior season in 1998. The point guard scored 894 points and dished out 452 assists.

The NCAA's all-time leading scorer, assistant Jackie Stiles poured in 3,393 points for Missouri State from 1997-2001. The three-time All-American and 2001 National Player of the Year led the Lady Bears to their second Final Four that season.

Assistant Jennifer Sullivan enjoyed a standout career at Memphis, piling up 800 points, 310 rebounds and 99 steals as a three-year starter for the Tigers.

MSU Peaks in The Valley

The Lady Bears are 289-139 all-time in MVC play with a 168-45 home record against league foes. Missouri State has won at least a share of 12 regular-season titles and nine conference tournaments since the 1989-90 season. MSU has played in 15 of the 24 Valley tournament championship games and 15 of the 31 title games since the inception of the Gateway Conference Tournament in 1983.

Missouri State All-Time

Missouri State is in its 48th season of women's collegiate basketball and has an all-time record of 814-565 (.590). MSU began formal competition in 1969 and, with a 24-10 mark in 2016, secured its 31st winning season. The Lady Bears have made 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by Final Four trips in 1992 and 2001 to go along with a Sweet 16 appearance in 1993.

The Lady Bears are in their 35th NCAA Division I season and 25th MVC year. MSU was in AIAW competition on the state, regional and national levels through the 1981-82 season, moved to Division I and Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference play in 1982-83 and started MVC competition in 1992-93 when the Gateway merged with The Valley.

"Q" Rating

After compiling a 325-108 record in Hammons Student Center over its 32-year stint as home of Missouri State basketball, the Lady Bears posted a 10-4 mark at home in 2015-16 to run their seven-year record to 83-38 in JQH Arena.

The "Q" is the fourth regular home of Missouri State women's basketball in the four-decade history of the program. The Lady Bears utilized both McDonald Arena and the Greenwood Laboratory School gym from 1969 until Hammons Student Center opened in 1976. MSU continued to play some of its home games at McDonald through the 1979-80 season.

Fandemonium

With the conclusion of their eighth season in JQH Arena, the Lady Bears finished first in the MVC standings in terms of attendance, drawing 47,594 fans in 14 home dates in 2015-16 for a 3,400 average. MSU has now led the MVC in attendance 24 times in the past 27 seasons, and ranked 32nd nationally in 2015-16.

Since the 1990-91 season, Missouri State has ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance 19 times, including a string of 10 straight top-10 finishes from 1992 through the 2000-01 season. The Lady Bears led all of Division I women's basketball in attendance during the 1992-93 season by averaging 7,421 fans per contest.

MSU ranks in the top 10 among all Division I women's basketball programs in average home attendance over the last two-plus decades, and is joined on that list by the likes of Tennessee and Connecticut. Additionally, the Lady Bears have finished in the top 50 nationally in per game attendance for 29 of the last 30 years.

Stiles Gets Statue

MSU assistant coach and NCAA Division I all-time leading scorer Jackie Stiles will have a statue constructed in her likeness outside JQH Arena. The unveiling will take place on Nov. 28.

Lady Bears on the Air

For the 32nd consecutive year, Missouri State Lady Bear basketball will be broadcast by Meyer Communications, which operates Springfield radio station KTXR (101.3 FM). All games will air live on either KTXR or "The Jock" 98.7 FM, and can also be heard over the internet at RadioSpringfield.com.

Tom Ladd will call the action for Missouri State, and former Lady Bear Dr. Lynne Miller will provide color commentary. Ladd will also host "Lady Bears Hotline with Kellie Harper" which will air primarily on "The Jock" 98.7 FM (KWTO) on Mondays at 6 p.m. during the regular season.

MSU begins its third year in a five-year partnership with Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc., to produce seven women's games on KOZL in Springfield. Don West, Tom Ackerman and former Lady Bear Carly Stubblefield will call the games on the Missouri State Television
