Game Overview

The Missouri State Lady Bears (12-10, 8-3 Missouri Valley Conference) seek their fifth consecutive victory Sunday at 7 p.m. when they host Evansville (8-15, 3-9) to cap a busy day at JQH Arena.

Sunday's festivities begin with the unveiling of the Jackie Stiles statue at 1:15 p.m. on the south side of JQH. The MSU men then take on UNI at 3 before the Lady Bears and Purple Aces meet in the nightcap.

Tickets for Sunday's Lady Bears' game are available for \$1, and hot dogs and bottled Coke products will be on sale for \$1 each in the concession stands.

The Lady Bears earned their eighth win in nine games Friday with a 73-59 victory against Southern Illinois, and look for the season sweep of UE after a 77-41 win at Evansville on Jan. 13.

Series History

The Lady Bears lead Evansville 37-12 in the all-time series, including a 20-2 record in Springfield. MSU has won 15 of the last 18 meetings.

Scouting Evansville

Evansville is 8-15 overall and 3-9 in MVC play with league wins against Indiana State, Loyola and Southern Illinois. Sara Dickey and Camary Williams have each scored 336 points for a 14.6 average, while Dickey is UE's all-time leading scorer and Williams averages 8.0 rebounds and 4.2 steals per contest, good for second nationally. As a team, the Purple Aces average 61.5 points and allow 67.3 while shooting 37.1 percent overall, 28.3 percent from 3-point land and 72.8 percent from the foul line.

Scouting the Lady Bears

Missouri State is 12-10 overall and 8-3 in MVC play, with junior guard Liza Fruendt leading the way in scoring at 15.3 points per game. Aubrey Buckley (9.6), Lexi Hughes (9.6) and Alexa Willard (8.4) follow Fruendt in the scoring column for a balanced offense that has seen nine different players score in double figures so far this season. MSU owns a plus-3.9 rebounding margin, with 10 players grabbing between 2.4 and 5.6 boards per game. As a team, the Lady Bears average 63.3 points and allow 63.5 while shooting 37.9 percent overall, 32.6 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent from the charity stripe.

First Meeting This Season

Missouri State led by double digits for nearly 33 minutes of game time in a 77-41 victory at Evansville on Jan. 13. The Lady Bears held the Purple Aces to 12-for-59 (.203) shooting and owned a 57-34 rebounding advantage. MSU placed four scorers in double figures, led by 19 from Liza Fruendt, while Alexa Willard added 14 and Aubrey Buckley and Danielle Gitzen tallied 10 apiece. Audrey Holt grabbed a season-high nine rebounds to share game-high honors with Rachel Swartz, and Lexi Hughes dished out seven assists.

Last Time Out

Missouri State picked up its eighth win in the last nine outings Friday evening, strengthening its hold on a top-three spot in the Missouri Valley Conference standings with a 73-59 victory against Southern Illinois at JQH Arena.

Junior Liza Fruendt scored a season-high 24 points, reaching double figures in the first seven minutes of the game and closing strong with nine fourth-quarter points.

Missouri State held a 16-15 lead after the first quarter and limited the Salukis to seven points in the second period on the way to a 32-22 halftime advantage.

The Salukis cut the gap to seven points early in the third period before Lexi Hughes started and ended a 10-0 run with 3-pointers for a 46-29 advantage with 5:28 on the clock. Alexa Willard, Shameka Ealy and Lee Ann Polowy added triples in the quarter for a 5-for-5 shooting period for MSU from long range, with Polowy's trey growing the lead

to 55-37 with 2:13 on the clock.

SIU twice pulled within single digits in the fourth quarter, and Fruendt answered each time, first with a trey for a 62-50 advantage before scoring six consecutive MSU points after the visitors closed to 62-54. Fruendt's final bucket sparked a 7-0 run that ended with Hughes scoring to make it 73-56 with less than a minute remaining.

Missouri State shot 28-for-60 (.467) in the game, with Fruendt shooting 9-for-17 in her eighth career 20-point game and Hughes (14) and Willard (11) finishing in double figures. The Lady Bears buried eight 3-pointers on 19 attempts, while holding the league's top 3-point percentage team to 6-for-23 (.261) from beyond the arc.

The Lady Bears turned 17 SIU turnovers into 22 points, with four players nabbing multiple steals. MSU committed only 10 turnovers of its own, and Audrey Holt grabbed a game-high seven rebounds.

Quick Hits

• Missouri State has ranked among the MVC's top three in total rebounds, offensive rebounds and rebounding margin for six consecutive seasons. The Lady Bears rank first in offensive boards in 2016-17, and grab 38.1 percent of missed shots this year, putting them above 35.9 percent for the eighth straight season. The league average this season is 31.6 percent.

• Missouri State became the 35th Division I team to reach 800 victories on Jan. 15, 2016, and entered the 2016-17 campaign ranked 33rd on the all-time wins list.

• Missouri State has finished fourth or better in the MVC standings 18 times in 24 seasons in the league.

• MSU is 21-7 in its last 28 road games, dating to Feb. 20, 2015, a stretch that included 10 consecutive MVC road wins. The Lady Bears are also 16-2 in their last 18 MVC road contests, and 14-2 in their last 16 games in the state of Illinois.

• The Lady Bears have shot at least 70 percent on a minimum of 10 free throw makes in 11 of 22 games this season. Missouri State has now made at least 10 free throws 14 times this year and in 121 of its last 149 games.

• Missouri State has played all available players in each game this season, and everyone has scored in four contests.

• MSU's 36-point win at Evansville on Jan. 13 was the school's largest margin of victory since a 96-55 win at Wichita State in 2005.

• The Lady Bears held Loyola to 32 points on Jan. 27, the lowest opponent output since defeating Eastern Illinois 80-32 on Jan. 2, 1992. MSU limited Indiana State to 46 points its next game, for a two-game total of 78 points to match the lowest since 1977. MSU has held 13 opponents below 50 points under Kellie Harper, 12 of those from the MVC.

• Brice Calip, Shameka Ealy and Alexa Willard have all scored 10 or more points in a game at least once the season, the first time since the 2008-09 campaign that three true freshmen have reached double figures during the same season for the Lady Bears. The trio has combined to score in double figures seven times this season.

• Nine different Lady Bears have scored in double figures at least once this season.

• MSU is 56-26 (.683) at home since the beginning of the 2011-12 season, averaging 72.0 points in those 82 games while topping the 70-point mark 50 times and scoring 80 or more 24 times.

• The Lady Bears are 44-6 under Harper when scoring at least 70 points, and 13-6 in games decided by five points or less.

• MSU is 58-1 under Harper when leading with 5:00 left on the game clock, and 61-2 when holding a lead with two minutes remaining. MSU's streak of 95 consecutive wins when leading at the five-minute mark came to an end on Jan. 22, nearly six years after it started.

Head Coach Kellie Harper

Kellie Harper is 68-52 in her fourth season at Missouri State and holds a 235-181 career record in her 13th season as a head coach, including four NCAA Tournament appearances and five WNIT berths in that span. She earned her 200th career coaching victory on Nov. 17, 2015 against MidAmerica Nazarene.

Her teams have historically played their best in the postseason, as she holds a collective 28-17 record in conference tournaments, NCAA Tournaments, and WNIT games. In fact, in 21 seasons as a Division I head coach, assistant coach and player, Harper has made 17 post-season appearances with a combined 471-224 (.678) record, 12 NCAA Tournament appearances and five WNIT bids.

Harper was the head coach at North Carolina State from 2009-2013, directing the Wolfpack to three postseason appearances during her four years at the helm, including the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

Prior to her stint in Raleigh, Harper piloted Western Carolina to a 97-65 record and four postseason berths in five seasons, including a 70-31 mark her final three seasons in Cullowhee as the Catamounts captured the first two Southern Conference Tournament titles in school history.

The former Kellie Jolly played on three national championship clubs at Tennessee for the legendary Pat Summitt and earned honorable mention All-America honors as a senior in 1999.

Harper and her husband Jon, who has served as an assistant on her coaching staff at Western Carolina, NC State, and now at Missouri State, welcomed their first child, Jackson, in November 2013.

High Scoring Staff

The 2016-17 Lady Bear coaching staff combined to score 5,087 points at the Division I level during their playing careers with four All-America seasons, four Final Four appearances and three national championships.

Head Coach Kellie (Jolly) Harper won three national titles at Tennessee under the legendary Pat Summitt, including a 39-0 junior season in 1998. The point guard scored 894 points and dished out 452 assists.

The NCAA's all-time leading scorer, assistant Jackie Stiles poured in 3,393 points for Missouri State from 1997-2001. The three-time All-American and 2001 National Player of the Year led the Lady Bears to their second Final Four that season.

Assistant Jennifer Sullivan enjoyed a standout career at Memphis, piling up 800 points, 310 rebounds and 99 steals as a three-year starter for the Tigers.

MSU Peaks in The Valley

The Lady Bears are 297-142 all-time in MVC play with a 171-48 home record against league foes. Missouri State has won at least a share of 12 regular-season titles and nine conference tournaments since the 1989-90 season. MSU has played in 15 of the 24 Valley tournament championship games and 15 of the 31 title games since the inception of the Gateway Conference Tournament in 1983.

Missouri State All-Time

Missouri State is in its 48th season of women's collegiate basketball and has an all-time record of 826-575 (.590). MSU began formal competition in 1969 and, with a 24-10 mark in 2016, secured its 31st winning season. The Lady Bears have made 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by Final Four trips in 1992 and 2001 to go along with a Sweet 16 appearance in 1993.

The Lady Bears are in their 35th NCAA Division I season and 25th MVC year. MSU was in AIAW competition on the state, regional and national levels through the 1981-82 season, moved to Division I and Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference play in 1982-83 and started MVC competition in 1992-93 when the Gateway merged with The Valley.

"Q" Rating

After compiling a 325-108 record in Hammons Student Center over its 32-year stint as home of Missouri State basketball, the Lady Bears posted a 10-4 mark at home in 2015-16 to run their seven-year record to 83-38 in JQH Arena.

The "Q" is the fourth regular home of Missouri State women's basketball in the four-decade history of the program. The Lady Bears utilized both McDonald Arena and the Greenwood Laboratory School gym from 1969 until Hammons Student Center opened in 1976. MSU continued to play some of its home games at McDonald through the 1979-80 season.

Fandemonium

With the conclusion of their eighth season in JQH Arena, the Lady Bears finished first in the MVC standings in terms of attendance, drawing 47,594 fans in 14 home dates in 2015-16 for a 3,400 average. MSU has now led the MVC in attendance 24 times in the past 27 seasons, and ranked 32nd nationally in 2015-16.

Since the 1990-91 season, Missouri State has ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance 19 times, including a string of 10 straight top-10 finishes from 1992 through the 2000-01 season. The Lady Bears led all of Division I women's basketball in attendance during the 1992-93 season by averaging 7,421 fans per contest.

MSU ranks in the top 10 among all Division I women's basketball programs in average home attendance over the last two-plus decades, and is joined on that list by the likes of Tennessee and Connecticut. Additionally, the Lady Bears have finished in the top 50 nationally in per game attendance for 29 of the last 30 years.

Stiles Gets Statue

MSU assistant coach and NCAA Division I all-time leading scorer Jackie Stiles will have a statue in her likeness unveiled outside JQH Arena on Feb. 12. The ceremony will take place at 1:15 p.m. that day on the southeast side of the building between the main entrance and the Jim D. Morris Basketball Complex.

Lady Bears on the Air

For the 32nd consecutive year, Missouri State Lady Bear basketball will be broadcast by Meyer Communications, which operates Springfield radio station KTXR (101.3 FM). All games will air live on either KTXR or "The Jock" 98.7 FM, and can also be heard over the internet at RadioSpringfield.com.

Tom Ladd will call the action for Missouri State, and former Lady Bear Dr. Lynne Miller will provide color commentary. Ladd will also host "Lady Bears Hotline with Kellie Harper" which will air primarily on "The Jock" 98.7 FM (KWTO) on Mondays at 6 p.m. during the regular season.

MSU begins its third year in a five-year partnership with Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc., to produce seven women's games on KOZL in Springfield. Don West, Tom Ackerman and former Lady Bear Carly Stubblefield will call the games on the Missouri State Television Network this season.

Network affiliates include St. Louis (MyNet 4.3); Kansas City (Time Warner SportsChannel); Columbia/Jefferson City (Mediacom / MC22); Lake of the Ozarks (LakeTV). The network also includes a 30-minute pregame show, Lady Bears Basketball Courtside. The network provides true HD telecasts on cable, satellite and over-the-air options for most affiliates.

The Valley on ESPN3

The Valley on ESPN3, part of the Missouri Valley Conference's media rights agreement with ESPN, will feature all MSU home games, road conference contests, and the MVC Tournament, with production done by home institutions. Select games are produced for the MVC's exclusive ESPN3 package. In all, 24 of Missouri State's 29 regular-season games, plus the MVC Tournament, can be viewed on ESPN3 and the WatchESPN app.
