The Missouri State volleyball team (26-8, 16-2 Missouri Valley Conference) earned an at-large bid into its ninth NCAA Tournament in the last 14 seasons and will begin play against Ohio State (20-12, 10-10 Big Ten) at 5 p.m. Friday in Manhattan, Kan.

The other two teams in Manhattan are host and No. 14 national seed Kansas State (20-9, 9-7 Big 12) and Lipscomb (22-7, 12-2 Atlantic Sun). Kansas State and Lipscomb play at 7:30 p.m. Friday, and the first-round winners are scheduled to play at 7 p.m. Saturday for the right to advance to the third and fourth rounds at a site to be determined after the first weekend of play.

The Bears are winners of 17 of their last 18 matches, and boast the MVC Player of the Year in Lily Johnson and MVC Freshman of the Year in Daniele Messa.

NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Missouri State is making its 12th NCAA appearance in the 35-year history of the event, and is 1-11 all-time. The Bears also made the field in 1982, 1990, 1993, 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011 and 2015. Below is a list of previous tournament results:

THE OPPONENTS

Ohio State is 20-12 on the season and tied for seventh in the Big Ten with a 10-10 conference record and RPI of 34. Led by first-team All-American Taylor Sandbothe, the Buckeyes hit .254 as a team and allow .200 to the opposition while averaging 13.98 kills, 1.34 aces, 1.94 blocks and 14.04 digs per set.

Kansas State is the No. 14 national seed, owning a 20-9 overall record and No. 18 ranking in the RPI after tying for fourth place in the Big 12. The Wildcats feature four all-Big 12 selections, and hit .242 with a .217 opponent attack efficiency and averages of 13.87 kills, 1.20 aces, 15.12 digs and 2.37 blocks per set.

Lipscomb is 22-7 and earned the automatic bid from the Atlantic Sun Conference. The Bisons are ranked 52nd in the RPI, and are led by ASUN Player of the Year Carlyle Nusbaum at 4.56 kills per set. Lipscomb hits .263 as a team and limits opponents to .189 while averaging 14.88 kills, 1.75 aces, 13.52 digs and 1.54 blocks per set.

SERIES HISTORIES

Missouri State is 4-2 all-time against Ohio State, including a five-set home win earlier this season. Lynsey Wright had a season-high 20 kills in that match, and the Buckeyes were ranked 12th nationally at the time.

The Bears own a 15-9 record against Kansas State, the last meeting being a 3-2 KSU win in Manhattan in 2014. MSU also visited Manhattan for the 2003 and 2007 NCAA Tournaments.

Missouri State and Lipscomb have not played in volleyball.

COACH MELISSA STOKES

Head Coach Melissa Stokes is 464-221 (.677) in her 21st season at Missouri State. She became the MVC's all-time winningest coach in league matches Sept. 30, 2011, when the Bears beat Bradley 3-1 for her 197th conference victory, and won her 400th career match against Miami (Fla.) on Sept. 13, 2014. A native of El Cajon, Calif., the MVC Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2016 has guided Missouri State to an overall record of 393-165 (.704) and 232-74 (.758) mark in the Missouri Valley Conference since 2000. The Bears have won MVC regular season championships in 2003 and 2016 under Stokes, making NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011 and 2015. MSU's lone postseason victory came at Arkansas in 2006.

Stokes came to Missouri State from the University of Idaho, where she helped the Vandals to four straight NCAA Tournament berths. As a setter at San Diego State, Stokes played four seasons and helped the Aztecs to two NCAA appearances. Stokes ranked 40th among active Division I coaches total victories and 43rd in win percentage entering 2015. Only four coaches ahead of Stokes on the wins list have coached fewer seasons.

QUICK SETS

• Head coach Melissa Stokes is climbing up the all-time MVC coaching lists in a number of categories. Listed below is the 21st-year coach's ranking in those categories. Lists are compiled based on statistics at Valley schools only:

- Third in total victories with 464
- First in MVC victories with 272
- Seventh in win percentage overall (.677) and third among active MVC coaches
- Seventh in win percentage in MVC matches only (.717)

• The Bears went 9-0 in the month of October, their first unbeaten month since posting an 8-0 mark in November 2005.

• MSU's 17-match winning streak from Sept. 30-Nov. 25 was the team's longest since winning 18 consecutive matches in the 2003 season, while the 16 straight MVC wins are a school record.

• Missouri State has won at least 20 matches in 17 of the last 18 seasons while posting winning records both overall and in Missouri Valley Conference play for 18 consecutive years.

• Missouri State ranks third all-time among Division I schools with 1,222 victories.

• Missouri State is 49-34 in five-set matches since the beginning of the 2006 season and has rallied from 0-2 deficits to win seven times since then as well.

• MSU is 204-34 since the beginning of 2006 when winning set two.

IMPRESSIVE RESUME

Missouri State played one of the nation's toughest non-conference schedules in 2016, with seven matches against NCAA Tournament teams from 2015 before adding six more during the MVC season.

The Bears currently own two victories against teams ranked in the AVCA's top 15 - No. 14 Illinois on Aug. 27 and 12th-ranked Ohio State on Sept. 9 - and six top-60 RPI wins. In fact, MSU's lowest-rated RPI loss of the season was in the opener against No. 59 Xavier.

MVC WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

The Bears picked up 18 MVC weekly awards this season. Lily Johnson was honored as the league's Player of the Week and Scholar-Athlete of the Week after the season's opening weekend. She averaged 3.92 kills, 3.00 digs, 0.31 aces and 0.31 blocks as the Bears defeated Arkansas and No. 14 Illinois.

Aubrey Cheffey was the Freshman of the Week on Sept. 6 after hitting .410 in three matches in Hawai'i, averaging 2.11 kills and 1.00 blocks per set with a .487 kill

percentage against 15th-ranked Hawai'i, No. 8 UCLA and Pacific.

Lynsey Wright was the Player of the Week on Sept. 12 after averaging of 4.08 kills, 4.65 points, 0.62 blocks, 0.23 aces and 0.62 digs per set as the MVP of the Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational. Wright had 20 kills and six blocks in MSU's win against No. 12 Ohio State.

Daniele Messa picked up top freshman honors the same week, with averages of 10.73 assists while helping the Bears to a .255 hitting percentage. She posted double-doubles against 12th-ranked Ohio State and IUPUI.

Johnson won MVC Player of the Week and Scholar-Athlete of the Week for a second time on Oct. 3 after posting three consecutive matches with at least 25 kills, including a career-high 33 on .368 hitting at Drake. She added MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Week a day later.

Messa grabbed her second freshman honor on Oct. 10 after averaging 11.17 assists, 0.83 blocks, 2.67 digs and 0.67 kills per set while leading the Bears to a .315 team hitting efficiency in sweeps of Bradley and Loyola.

Messa made it two weeks in a row on Oct. 17 after she averaged 12 assists and 2.91 digs per set while running an MSU offense that averaged 14.64 kills per set on .301 hitting in wins over Evansville, Illinois State and Indiana State.

House earned Player of the Week honors on Oct. 24, and Messa earned her third consecutive freshman award the same day. House hit .444 with nine kills and five blocks in MSU's win at Wichita State, while Messa finished the match with 37 assists, 16 digs, four kills and a block.

Johnson averaged 5.86 kills, 6.57 points and 3.29 digs per set in wins against Drake and UNI to collect her third Player of the Week and Scholar-Athlete of the Week awards of the season on Oct. 31.

Messa grabbed her fourth straight freshman honor the same week after averages of 13.43 assist and 4.00 digs while guiding the Bears to a .279 attack efficiency.

It was Johnson and Messa again on Nov. 7, as Johnson hit .333 with averages of 6.17 kills and 4.00 digs per set for her fourth win of the year.

Messa made it five weeks in a row after setting MSU to a .323 team hitting percentage and averaging 13.67 kills and 2.83 digs per set.

Butters added an MVC Scholar-Athlete honor on Nov. 8 after averaging 6.67 digs per set and becoming the first MSU sophomore to surpass 1,000 career digs.

Messa won her seventh FOW on Nov. 14, averaging 11.43 assists, 1.14 kills, 2.57 digs

SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

Brianne Dixon and Lily Johnson earned spots on the CoSIDA Academic All-District VI First Team, and were joined by Emily Butters as MSU's representatives on the MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team.

Both cell and molecular biology majors, Dixon and Johnson carry GPAs of 4.00 and 3.99, respectively, while Butters owns a 3.92 GPA in exercise and movement science.

Dixon also earned the MVC Elite 18 award for the second consecutive season, given annually to the student-athlete with the highest GPA in the conference title match.

SIX IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The number six has been a milestone number the last 18-plus seasons in terms of winning streaks, as the Bears have strung together at least six consecutive wins a total of 22 times since the beginning of the 1999 season. MSU had a seven-match winning streak from Sept. 3-16 this season, and went on a 17-match streak from Sept. 30-Nov. 25.

HOMECOMING

Missouri State has been dominant at home since 2000, compiling a record of 187-45 for an .806 winning percentage at Hammons Student Center.

The Bears went 11-2 in 2016 and have won at least 64 percent of their home matches in 17 consecutive seasons.

Missouri State boasts two players from Springfield on its 2016 roster (Brianne Dixon and Gerri Idos from Kickapoo High) and a total of eight players from southwest Missouri, including Lauren Boone (Branson), MacKenzie Irwin (Joplin), Laynie Dake (Mount Vernon), Ashley Ophoven and Paige Perry (Ozark), and Aubrey Cheffey (Nixa). In all, 10 of MSU's 18 players hail from the Show-Me State.

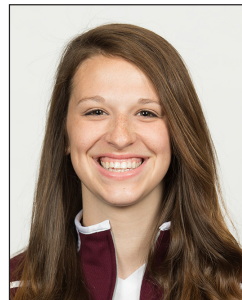
