The Missouri State volleyball team begins the 2017 season this week with three matches in North Carolina, starting with an 11 a.m. Friday contest at Appalachian State. The Bears, who are coming off their ninth NCAA Tournament appearance since 2003 and seventeenth 20-win season in the last 18 years, then head to Raleigh to take on No. 8 Kansas at 9:30 a.m. Saturday and North Carolina State and 2:30 that afternoon.

Missouri State is the near unanimous favorite to repeat as Missouri Valley Conference champions in 2017, and faces a rigorous non-conference schedule that includes trips to Ohio State from Sept. 1-2 and Pepperdine (Sept. 8-9) before opening the home slate with the annual Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational Sept. 14-16.

THE OPPONENTS

Appalachian State is picked to finish fifth in the Sun Belt East Division this year, with sophomore outside hitter Emma Longley earning preseason all-conference honors after averaging 3.24 kills and 2.54 digs per set in 2016. The Mountaineers went 4-25 overall and 2-14 in Sun Belt play last season.

Kansas is ranked eighth in the preseason AVCA poll after going 27-3 a year ago. The defending Big 12 champions are picked to finish second in that league this year, with setter Ainise Havili and outside hitter Madison Rigdon earning preseason all-Big 12 honors, and right side hitter Kelsie Payne being tabbed the conference's preseason player of the year.

North Carolina State went 20-12 last season and won a school-record 13 Atlantic Coast Conference matches on the way to a final rating of 64th in the NCAA RPI. The Wolfpack return their top five point scorers from last year and are picked to finish fifth in the ACC, with senior outside hitters Julia Brown and Bree Bailey picking up preseason all-conference honors.

SERIES HISTORIES

Friday's match will be the first meeting between MSU and Appalachian State in volleyball.

The Bears own a 28-7-1 series lead over Kansas, though the Jayhawks won matches in 2007 and 2015 as the only meetings in the series since 1994.

Missouri State has played North Carolina State once, winning in five sets on Aug. 31, 1996, in Evanston, Ill., for Melissa Stokes' first victory at MSU.

COACH MELISSA STOKES

Head Coach Melissa Stokes is 464-222 (.676) in her 22nd season at Missouri State. She became the MVC's all-time winningest coach in league matches Sept. 30, 2011, when the Bears beat Bradley 3-1 for her 197th conference victory, and won her 400th career match against Miami (Fla.) on Sept. 13, 2014. A native of El Cajon, Calif., the

MVC Coach of the Year in 2003 and both MVC and AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 2016 has guided Missouri State to an overall record of 393-166 (.703) and 232-74 (.758) mark in the Missouri Valley

Conference since 2000. The Bears have won MVC regular season championships in 2003 and 2016 under Stokes, making NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2015 and 2016. MSU's lone postseason victory came at Arkansas in 2006.

Stokes came to Missouri State from the University of Idaho, where she helped the Vandals to four straight NCAA Tournament berths. As a setter at San Diego State, Stokes played four seasons and helped the Aztecs to two NCAA appearances. Stokes ranked 35th among active Division I coaches in both total victories and win percentage entering 2017. Only four coaches ahead of Stokes on the wins list have coached fewer seasons.

2016 IN REVIEW

The 2016 Bears went 26-9 overall and won the Missouri Valley Conference regular season title with a 16-2 league record. The Bears earned an at-large bid to their ninth NCAA Tournament in the last 14 seasons, falling to Ohio State in the first round in Manhattan, Kan. Missouri State went 9-5 during a challenging non-conference schedule that included four top-15 opponents, with the Bears claiming wins over No. 14 Illinois and 12th-ranked Ohio State. MSU dropped its first two MVC matches in five sets before ripping off 17 wins in a row entering the MVC Tournament final. Lily Johnson led the MVC in kills and earned AVCA All-America honors for the third consecutive season as the MVC Player of the Year, Daniele Messa was the MVC Freshman of the year, and seven total Bears earned conference recognition at some point during the season, as well as Melissa Stokes taking home MVC and AVCA Region Coach of the Year honors.

• Missouri State's active 16-match MVC regular-season win streak is the longest in school history. The streak began with a victory at UNI on Sept. 30, 2016.

• Missouri State has won at least 20 matches in 17 of the last 18 seasons while posting winning records both overall and in Missouri Valley Conference play for 18 consecutive years.

• Missouri State ranks third all-time among Division I schools with 1,222 victories.

• Missouri State is 49-34 in five-set matches since the beginning of the 2006 season and has rallied from 0-2 deficits to win seven times since then as well.

• MSU is 204-34 since the beginning of 2006 when winning set two.

• The Bears have a veteran roster, with combined college playing experience of 2,243 sets and 704 matches, as well as totals of 3,729 kills, 1,907 assists, 260 aces, 3,563 digs and 626 blocks.

SCHEDULE

Missouri State beefed up its non-conference schedule once again this season, with five matches against teams that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, and eight against top-100 RPI teams. The Bears also play three AVCA preseason top-25 teams, and one that received votes in the poll.

USA! USA!

MSU's Emily Butters, Lily Johnson and Lynsey Wright have each played for Team USA the last two summers after attending U.S. Women's National Team Open Try-outs at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs. Johnson played with the Collegiate National Team in Europe in 2016 and Thailand in 2017, while Butters and Wright played in Indianapolis and Minneapolis as part of USA Volleyball's High Performance pipeline.

ALL-AMERICANS

Several players on the MSU roster can call themselves All-Americans at either the college or high school level. Senior Lily Johnson is a three-time AVCA Honorable Mention All-America selection during her time as a Bear, and she is joined by Sam Brinkmann, Aubrey Cheffey, Ashley Dudenhoeffer, Emelie Orlando, Veronica Snelling and Cambree Villarreal as players who earned the distinction during their prep careers.

SIX IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The number six has been a milestone number the last 18-plus seasons in terms of winning streaks, as the Bears have strung together at least six consecutive wins a total of 22 times since the beginning of the 1999 season. In fact, Missouri State has

HOME COMING

Missouri State has been dominant at home since 2000, compiling a record of 187-45 for an .806 winning percentage at Hammons Student Center.

The Bears went 11-2 in 2016 and have won at least 64 percent of their home matches in 17 consecutive seasons.

Missouri State boasts two players from Springfield on its 2017 roster (Brienne Dixon and Gerri Idos from Kickapoo High) and a total of seven players from southwest Missouri, including Lauren Boone (Branson), MacKenzie Irwin (Joplin), Laynie Dake (Mount Vernon), Ashley Ophoven (Ozark), and Aubrey Cheffey (Nixa). In all, 11 of MSU's 20 players hail from the Show-Me State.
