The Missouri State volleyball team (4-2) continues its rigorous non-conference schedule in California this week with three matches at the Pepperdine Asics Classic.

The Bears open play at noon Central Friday against eighth-ranked Washington, and also take on Wyoming at 7 p.m. Friday before facing the host Waves at 6:30 p.m. Saturday.

Missouri State, which received 10 votes in this week's AVCA Poll to check in at the No. 31 spot, is the near unanimous favorite to repeat as Missouri Valley Conference champions in 2017. The Bears open the home slate with the annual Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational Sept. 14-16, hosting Illinois, Washington State, Chattanooga and Tennessee State.

THE OPPONENTS

Washington is 5-1 on the year and ranked eighth in the latest AVCA Poll. The Huskies return all six starters from last season's 29-5 club that advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, and is picked to win the Pac-12 this season. As a team, UW hits .301 and allows a .199 attack efficiency with averages of 14.26 kills, 1.63 aces, 12.68 digs and 3.58 blocks per set.

Wyoming is 3-3 overall with wins against South Dakota, Eastern Michigan and Jacksonville and a five-set home loss to No. 21 Purdue. The Cowgirls are picked to finish fourth in the Mountain West this season and return the bulk of a team that went 18-13 in 2016. Wyoming hits .233 as a team and averages 12.62 kills, 1.25 aces, 12.25 digs and 2.54 blocks per set.

Pepperdine is 4-2 on the year and is predicted to finish sixth in the West Coast Conference in 2017. Jasmine Gross is a preseason all-WCC middle blocker and hits a team-high .362. As a team, the Waves hit .232 compared to a .189 for the opposition with averages of 13.96 kills, 1.65 aces, 16.43 digs and 2.20 blocks per set.

SERIES HISTORIES

Missouri State and Wyoming have played once, with the Cowgirls winning 3-0 in the 1985 Montana State Classic.

The Bears are 1-4 all-time versus Washington, with just one meeting in the last 30 years, a 3-0 UW win in 2002. Ironically, MSU's win against the Huskies came in the 1985 Montana State Classic.

MSU is 0-1 against Pepperdine, losing in three sets in the first round of the 2011 NCAA Tournament in Malibu.

COACH MELISSA STOKES

Head Coach Melissa Stokes is 468-224 (.676) in her 22nd season at Missouri State. She became the MVC's all-time winningest coach in league matches Sept. 30, 2011,

when the Bears beat Bradley 3-1 for her 197th conference victory, and won her 400th career match against Miami (Fla.) on Sept. 13, 2014. A native of El Cajon, Calif., the MVC Coach of the Year in 2003 and both MVC and AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 2016 has guided Missouri State to an overall record of 397-168 (.703) and 232-74 (.758) mark in the Missouri Valley Conference since 2000. The Bears have won MVC regular season championships in 2003 and 2016 under Stokes, making NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2015 and 2016. MSU's lone postseason victory came at Arkansas in 2006.

Stokes came to Missouri State from the University of Idaho, where she helped the Vandals to four straight NCAA Tournament berths. As a setter at San Diego State, Stokes played four seasons and helped the Aztecs to two NCAA appearances. Stokes ranked 35th among active Division I coaches in both total victories and win percentage entering 2017. Only four coaches ahead of Stokes on the wins list have coached fewer seasons.

LAST WEEK

The Bears went 2-1 at Ohio State's tournament, winning the event with an 8-4 record in sets played.

Friday, Lynsey Wright hit .577 with 15 kills and no errors to lead the Bears past 20th-ranked Ohio State in four sets to begin her tournament MVP and MVC Player of the Week performance.

Saturday, MSU lost a 2-0 set lead to Lipscomb in the morning match, but rebounded in the afternoon for a sweep of Oakland behind 14 kills from Lily Johnson.

• Missouri State's active 16-match MVC regular-season win streak is the longest in school history. The streak began with a victory at UNI on Sept. 30, 2016.

• Missouri State has won at least 20 matches in 17 of the last 18 seasons while posting winning records both overall and in Missouri Valley Conference play for 18 consecutive years.

• Missouri State ranks third all-time among Division I schools with 1,226 victories.

• Missouri State is 50-35 in five-set matches since the beginning of the 2006 season and has rallied from 0-2 deficits to win seven times since then as well. The Bears are also 16-9 in the fifth set since the beginning of 2015.

• MSU is 207-35 since the beginning of 2006 when winning set two.

• The Bears have a veteran roster, with combined college playing experience of 2,534 sets and 785 matches, as well as totals of 4,072 kills, 2,236 assists, 286 aces, 3,959 digs and 670.5 blocks.

POWER FIVE WINS A REGULARITY

With wins on Aug. 26 at North Carolina State and Sept. 1 at No. 20 Ohio State, Missouri State now has 26 victories over schools from Power Five football schools under Melissa Stokes.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Lily Johnson earned MSU's first weekly award of 2017 with an MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Week honor on Aug. 30, the sixth of her career. Johnson average 4.57 kills, 3.21 digs, 0.36 aces, 0.43 blocks and 5.18 points per set during the season's opening weekend.

Lynsey Wright averaged 3.08 kills and 0.92 blocks per set with a .462 attack efficiency and .569 kill percentage to earn MVC Player of the Week on Sept. 5. Wright surpassed 1,000 kills on a weekend that was highlighted by her error-free 15-kill performance in a win at 20th-ranked Ohio State.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Missouri State beefed up its non-conference schedule once again this season, with five matches against teams that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, and eight against top-100 RPI teams from last year. So far, the Bears have played two teams ranked in the AVCA top-25, with five more matches scheduled against teams either currently ranked or receiving votes in the poll.

Johnson played with the Collegiate National Team in Europe in 2016 and Thailand in 2017, while Butters and Wright played in Indianapolis and Minneapolis as part of USA Volleyball's High Performance pipeline.

ALL-AMERICANS

Several players on the MSU roster can call themselves All-Americans at either the college or high school level. Senior Lily Johnson is a three-time AVCA Honorable Mention All-America selection during her time as a Bear, and she is joined by Sam Brinkmann, Aubrey Cheffey, Ashley Dudenhoeffer, Emelie Orlando, Veronica Snelling and Cambree Villarreal as players who earned the distinction during their prep careers.

SIX IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The number six has been a milestone number the last 18-plus seasons in terms of winning streaks, as the Bears have strung together at least six consecutive wins a total of 22 times since the beginning of the 1999 season. In fact, Missouri State has 74 separate streaks of at least six consecutive wins in its history, along with 21 double-figure streaks, with five of those coming during Stokes's tenure.

HOMECOMING

Missouri State has been dominant at home since 2000, compiling a record of 187-45 for an .806 winning percentage at Hammons Student Center.

The Bears went 11-2 in 2016 and have won at least 64 percent of their home matches in 17 consecutive seasons.

LOCAL FLAVOR

Missouri State boasts two players from Springfield on its 2017 roster (Brianne Dixon and Gerri Idos from Kickapoo High) and a total of seven players from southwest Missouri, including Lauren Boone (Branson), MacKenzie Irwin (Joplin), Laynie Dake (Mount Vernon), Ashley Ophoven (Ozark), and Aubrey Cheffey (Nixa). In all, 11 of MSU's 20 players hail from the Show-Me State.
