The Missouri State volleyball team (14-5, 6-0 Missouri Valley Conference) heads to Iowa this week to face the MVC's other two unbeaten clubs as the Valley has seen an unprecedented three schools win their first six league matches. The Bears take on Drake (17-3, 6-0) at 7 p.m. Friday and No. 20 UNI (16-4, 6-0) at 7 p.m. Saturday, and bring win streaks of seven matches overall, 22 consecutive regular-season MVC matches, 16 overall road wins and 15 MVC road victories with them to Iowa.

THE OPPONENTS

Drake is off to its best start in decades with a 17-3 overall record and 6-0 MVC mark after winning its last 10 matches. The Bulldogs are led by senior outside hitter Kyla Inderski, who averages 3.38 kills and 3.49 digs per set, and hit .210 as a team compared to .165 for the opposition. The Bulldogs average 13.37 kills, 1.12 aces, 18.21 digs and 1.86 blocks per set.

UNI is ranked 20th in the most recent AVCA Coaches Poll, and is 16-4 overall and 6-0 in conference play with four top-25 wins on the season. Karlie Taylor, Piper Thomas and Bri Weber all average at least 3.3 kills per set for the Panthers, who hit .244 as a team and hold opponents to a .173 efficiency with averages of 14.86 kills, 1.09 aces, 18.38 digs and 1.82 blocks per set.

SERIES HISTORIES

MSU is 59-9 against Drake and has won 35 of the last 36 meetings, the exception being a loss in Springfield in 2010.

The all-time series with UNI is 49-23 in favor of the Panthers. MSU has won the last three meetings, including its first win in Cedar Falls since 1990 last year, after UNI won 13 of 14.

COACH MELISSA STOKES

Head Coach Melissa Stokes is 478-227 (.678) in her 22nd season at Missouri State. She became the MVC's all-time winningest coach in league matches Sept. 30, 2011, when the Bears beat Bradley 3-1 for her 197th conference victory, and won her 400th career match against Miami (Fla.) on Sept. 13, 2014. A native of El Cajon, Calif., the MVC Coach of the Year in 2003 and both MVC and AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 2016 has guided Missouri State to an overall record of 403-168 (.706) and 238-74 (.763) mark in the Missouri Valley Conference since 2000. The Bears have won MVC regular season championships in 2003 and 2016 under Stokes, making NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2015 and 2016. MSU's lone postseason victory came at Arkansas in 2006.

Stokes came to Missouri State from the University of Idaho, where she helped the Vandals to four straight NCAA Tournament berths. As a setter at San Diego State, Stokes played four seasons and helped the Aztecs to two NCAA appearances. Stokes

ranked 35th among active Division I coaches in both total victories and win percentage entering 2017. Only four coaches ahead of Stokes on the wins list have coached fewer seasons.

LAST WEEK

Missouri State improved its winning streak to seven matches with a 3-0 win at Southern Illinois on Oct. 7. The Bears hit .306 as a team, led by Lily Johnson's 14 kills and 15 digs and Lynsey Wright's 12 kills on .429 hitting, while Daniele Messa added a double-double with 32 assists and 11 digs.

QUICK SETS

• Head coach Melissa Stokes is climbing up the all-time MVC coaching lists in a number of categories. Listed below is the 22nd-year coach's ranking in those categories. Lists are compiled based on statistics at Valley schools only:

- Third in total victories with 478
 - First in MVC victories with 278
 - Sixth in win percentage overall (.678) and second among active MVC coaches
 - Seventh in win percentage in MVC matches only (.724)
- Missouri State's active 22-match MVC regular-season win streak is the longest in school history and sixth-longest in conference history. The streak began with a victory at UNI on Sept. 30, 2016. It also equals the MSU baseball team's 22-match streak from 2016-17 as the longest MVC win streak for any Missouri State program.
- The Bears have won 16 consecutive true road matches, the longest active streak in the country, with their last loss in an opposing gym coming at Marquette on Sept. 17, 2016. MSU has also won its last 15 MVC road matches, last losing at Illinois State on Oct. 24, 2015.
- Missouri State's current .247 team hitting percentage would rank as the second-best for a full season in school history behind only the 2003 club's .263 figure.

MSU's Lily Johnson and Lynsey Wright have combined for 3,188 career kills, the highest for any pair of teammates nationally, while Johnson and Emily Butters rank as the No. 3 duo in the country with 2,920 combined career digs.

Missouri State is 6-0 in the MVC for the sixth time in school history and first since 2009. The Bears started 6-0 in 2006, 8-0 in 1992, 2002 and 2009, and 15-0 in 2003.

Missouri State has won at least 20 matches in 17 of the last 18 seasons while posting winning records both overall and in Missouri Valley Conference play for 18 consecutive years.

Missouri State ranks fourth all-time among Division I schools with 1,236 victories.

Missouri State is 51-37 in five-set matches since the beginning of the 2006 season and has rallied from 0-2 deficits to win seven times since then as well.

MSU is 217-37 since the beginning of 2006 when winning set two.

The Bears have a veteran roster, with combined college playing experience of 3,072 sets and 964 matches, as well as totals of 4,751 kills, 2,783 assists, 348 aces, 4,842 digs and 756 blocks.

POWER FIVE WINS A REGULARITY

With wins on Aug. 26 at North Carolina State and Sept. 1 at No. 20 Ohio State, Missouri State now has 26 victories over schools from Power Five football schools under Melissa Stokes.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Lily Johnson earned MSU's first weekly award of 2017 with an MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Week honor on Aug. 30, the sixth of her career. Johnson average 4.57 kills, 3.21 digs, 0.36 aces, 0.43 blocks and 5.18 points per set during the season's opening weekend.

Lynsey Wright averaged 3.08 kills and 0.92 blocks per set with a .462 attack efficiency and .569 kill percentage to earn MVC Player of the Week on Sept. 5. Wright surpassed 1,000 kills on a weekend that was highlighted by her error-free 15-kill performance in a win at 20th-ranked Ohio State.

Johnson was MVC Player of the Week award on Sept. 11 after averaging 4.45 kills and 4.45 digs at Pepperdine's tournament, including 15 kills, 18 digs and four aces versus No. 8 Washington and 26 kills on .383 hitting at Pepperdine.

Emily Butters earned Defensive Player of the Week recognition Sept. 11 following a week in which she averaged 6.36 digs per set and 27 digs against both Pepperdine and eighth-ranked Washington.

Johnson set the MVC record with her 11th career Player of the Week award on Sept. 18 following a weekend in which she set the MSU record for career kills. Johnson had 75 total kills in four matches, average 4.69 per set, including 27 against Illinois and a 23-kill, 22-dig performance vs. Washington State.

Johnson picked up Defensive Player of the Week honors Oct. 2 after averaging 4.44 digs and 0.89 blocks per set in three home sweeps. She also tallied 3.22 kills and 4.39 points on .299 hitting on the offensive side while recording her 2,000th career kill against Indiana State on Sept. 29.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Missouri State beefed up its non-conference schedule once again this season, with five matches against teams that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, and eight against top-100 RPI teams from last year. So far, the Bears have played three teams ranked in the AVCA top-25 and three more versus teams receiving votes, with two more matches schedule against ranked opponents.

USA! USA!

MSU's Emily Butters, Lily Johnson and Lynsey Wright have each played for Team USA the last two summers after attending U.S. Women's National Team Open Tryouts at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs. Johnson played with the Collegiate National Team in Europe in 2016 and Thailand in 2017, while Butters and Wright played in Indianapolis and Minneapolis as part of USA Volleyball's High Performance pipeline.

ALL-AMERICANS

Several players on the MSU roster can call themselves All-Americans at either the college or high school level. Senior Lily Johnson is a three-time AVCA Honorable Mention All-America selection during her time as a Bear, and she is joined by Sam Brinkmann, Aubrey Cheffey, Ashley Dudenhoeffer, Emelie Orlando, Veronica Snelling and Cambree Villarreal as players who earned the distinction during their prep careers.

SIX IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The number six has been a milestone number the last 18-plus seasons in terms of winning streaks, as the Bears have strung together at least six consecutive wins a total of 23 times since the beginning of the 1999 season. In fact, Missouri State has 75 separate streaks of at least six consecutive wins in its history, along with 21 double-figure streaks, with five of those coming during Stokes's tenure.

HOME COMING

Missouri State has been dominant at home since 2000, compiling a record of 192-47 for an .803 winning percentage at Hammons Student Center.

The Bears are 5-2 in 2017 and have won at least 64 percent of their home matches in 17 consecutive seasons.

LOCAL FLAVOR

Missouri State boasts two players from Springfield on its 2017 roster (Brianna Dixon and Gerri Idos from Kickapoo High) and a total of seven players from southwest Missouri, including Lauren Boone (Branson), MacKenzie Irwin (Joplin), Laynie Dake (Mount Vernon), Ashley Ophoven (Ozark), and Aubrey Cheffey (Nixa). In all, 11 of MSU's 20 players hail from the Show-Me State.
