The Missouri State volleyball team (18-5, 10-0 Missouri Valley Conference) will play the league's three Indiana schools this week, taking the nation's longest road winning streak to Evansville (9-13, 3-7) at 7 p.m. Friday and Indiana State (7-15, 5-5) at 6 p.m. Saturday before returning home for a 7 p.m. Monday match against MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12-11, 4-6).

THE OPPONENTS

Evansville 9-13 on the year and 3-7 in MVC matches, with the three league victories coming the last four outings. The Purple Aces, who opened the season with five consecutive wins, hit .150 as a team and limit opponents to .192 while averaging 11.02 kills, 1.29 aces, 15.76 digs and 1.85 blocks per set.

Indiana State is 7-15 and 5-5 in MVC play. Laura Gross leads the Sycamores with 3.22 kills and 3.61 digs per set, and ISU hits .199 as a team compared to .243 for the opposition with averages of 11.81 kills, 1.01 aces, 15.80 digs and 1.82 blocks per set.

Valparaiso is 12-11 and 4-6 in conference play. The Crusaders lead the nation by a wide margin with 20.39 digs per set, and hit .182 as a team compared to .173 for opponents with averages of 12.95 kills, 1.35 aces and 2.33 blocks per set.

SERIES HISTORIES

The Bears lead Evansville by a 45-3 margin, losing just twice since 1999.

MSU leads the all-time series with Indiana State by a 62-1 margin, with the Bears' lone loss occurring in five sets in 1994. Since then, the Bears have reeled off 48 straight wins against the Sycamores.

The Bears are 2-0 all-time against Valparaiso, earning home sweeps in 1999 and 2006.

FIRST MEETINGS THIS SEASON

Missouri State swept Indiana State at home on Sept. 29 and did the same to Evansville the next night, holding both opponents below 20 points in all six sets. The Bears limited Evansville to a negative hitting efficiency while Lily Johnson hit .407 with 12 kills and 13 digs. Against Indiana State, Johnson recorded her 2,000th career kill and the Bears hit .299 as a team.

LAST WEEK

Missouri State defeated Bradley and Illinois State at home in a pair of hard-fought matches. Friday, the Bears won 19-17 in the fifth set behind Lily Johnson's 22 kills and 21 digs. Saturday, MSU took down the Redbirds 3-1 as Emily Butters had 35 digs and Johnson added 27 to help the Bears hold ISU to a .137 hitting percentage.

COACH MELISSA STOKES

Head Coach Melissa Stokes is 482-227 (.680) in her 22nd season at Missouri State. She became the MVC's all-time winningest coach in league matches Sept. 30, 2011, when the Bears beat Bradley 3-1 for her 197th conference victory, and won her 400th career match against Miami (Fla.) on Sept. 13, 2014. A native of El Cajon, Calif., the MVC Coach of the Year in 2003 and both MVC and AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 2016 has guided Missouri State to an overall record of 407-168 (.708) and 242-74 (.766) mark in the Missouri Valley Conference since 2000. The Bears have won MVC regular season championships in 2003 and 2016 under Stokes, making NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003,

2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2015 and 2016. MSU's lone postseason victory came at Arkansas in 2006.

Stokes came to Missouri State from the University of Idaho, where she helped the Vandals to four straight NCAA Tournament berths. As a setter at San Diego State, Stokes played four seasons and helped the Aztecs to two NCAA appearances. Stokes ranked 35th among active Division I coaches in both total victories and win percentage entering 2017. Only four coaches ahead of Stokes on the wins list have coached fewer seasons.

QUICK SETS

• Head coach Melissa Stokes is climbing up the all-time MVC coaching lists in a number of categories. Listed below is the 22nd-year coach's ranking in those categories. Lists are compiled based on statistics at Valley schools only:

• Third in total victories with 482

• First in MVC victories with 282

• Sixth in win percentage overall (.680) and second among active MVC coaches

• Seventh in win percentage in MVC matches only (.727)

• Missouri State's active 26-match MVC regular-season win streak is the longest in school history and sixth-longest in conference history. The streak began with a victory at UNI on Sept. 30, 2016, and is the longest MVC win streak for any Missouri State program.

• The Bears have won 18 consecutive true road matches, the longest active streak in the country, with their last loss in an opposing gym coming at Marquette on Sept. 17, 2016. MSU has also won its last 17 MVC road matches, last losing at Illinois State on Oct. 24, 2015.

• Including this year's 11-match win streak that began Sept. 16, MSU has had a streak of at least nine consecutive victories in three consecutive seasons.

• The Bears set school records for digs (153) and attacks (266) in a match Oct. 13 at Drake, adding several individual superlatives as well. Emily Butters (44), Lily Johnson (32) and Daniele Messa (29) all set career highs for digs, becoming the first three teammates in school history to all reach 25 digs in the same match. Butters and Johnson also became

the first duo with 30 digs in the same match. The team's dig total is the most in the NCAA this season.

- MSU's Lily Johnson and Lynsey Wright have combined for 3,333 career kills, the highest for any pair of teammates nationally, while Johnson and Emily Butters rank as the No. 3 duo in the country with 3,114 combined career digs.

- Missouri State is off to its second-best MVC start in school history after the 2003 club won its first 15 league matches.

- Missouri State has won at least 20 matches in 17 of the last 18 seasons while posting winning records both overall and in Missouri Valley Conference play for 18 consecutive years.

- Missouri State ranks fourth all-time among Division I schools with 1,240 victories.

- Missouri State is 53-37 in five-set matches since the beginning of the 2006 season and has rallied from 0-2 deficits to win seven times since then as well.

- MSU is 219-37 since the beginning of 2006 when winning set two.

- The Bears have a veteran roster, with combined college playing experience of 3,273 sets and 1,015 matches, as well as totals of 5,022 kills, 3,042 assists, 357 aces, 5,290 digs and 792.5 blocks.

POWER FIVE WINS A REGULARITY

With wins on Aug. 26 at North Carolina State and Sept. 1 at No. 20 Ohio State, Missouri State now has 26 victories over schools from Power Five football schools under Melissa Stokes.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Lily Johnson earned MSU's first weekly award of 2017 with an MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Week honor on Aug. 30, the sixth of her career. Johnson average 4.57 kills, 3.21 digs, 0.36 aces, 0.43 blocks and 5.18 points per set during the season's opening weekend.

Lynsey Wright averaged 3.08 kills and 0.92 blocks per set with a .462 attack efficiency and .569 kill percentage to earn MVC Player of the Week on Sept. 5. Wright surpassed 1,000 kills on a weekend that was highlighted by her error-free 15-kill performance in a win at 20th-ranked Ohio State.

Johnson was MVC Player of the Week award on Sept. 11 after averaging 4.45 kills and 4.45 digs at Pepperdine's tournament, including 15 kills, 18 digs and four aces versus No. 8 Washington and 26 kills on .383 hitting at Pepperdine.

Emily Butters earned Defensive Player of the Week recognition Sept. 11 following a week in which she averaged 6.36 digs per set and 27 digs against both Pepperdine and eighth-ranked Washington.

Johnson set the MVC record with her 11th career Player of the Week award on Sept. 18 following a weekend in which she set the MSU record for career kills. Johnson had 75 total kills in four matches, average 4.69 per set, including 27 against Illinois and a 23-kill, 22-dig

Johnson picked up Defensive Player of the Week honors Oct. 2 after averaging 4.44 digs and 0.89 blocks per set in three home sweeps. She also tallied 3.22 kills and 4.39 points on the offensive side while recording her 2,000th career kill against Indiana State on Sept. 29.

Johnson earned MVC Player and Scholar-Athlete, as well as AVCA and VolleyMob National Player of the Week honors Oct. 16 after averaging 5.56 kills and 5.56 digs per set in wins at Drake and No. 20 UNI, including a 28-kill, 32-dig performance at DU and finishing the UNI match with 12 kills in the fourth set alone.

Butters scooped 7.44 digs per set and went 97-for-97 on serve receive at Drake and UNI to win defensive honors on Oct. 16, including 44 digs at Drake, the second-most in MSU and fifth-highest total in MVC history.

Johnson added another MVC Player and Scholar-Athlete of the Week Oct. 23 after she totaled 40 kills, 48 digs, 47.5 points, four aces and five blocks in wins against Bradley and Illinois State.

GREAT RESUME

The Bears own three RPI top 50 road wins on the year (Ohio State, UNI, NC State), and a pair victories against AVCA top-20 teams. Additionally, MSU has won eight total sets in its five losses, three of which have been to top-23 RPI teams. The Bears have played four teams ranked in the AVCA top-25 and three more versus teams receiving votes, with one more match schedule against ranked opponents.

USA! USA!

MSU's Emily Butters, Lily Johnson and Lynsey Wright have each played for Team USA the last two summers after attending U.S. Women's National Team Open Tryouts at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs. Johnson played with the Collegiate National Team in Europe in 2016 and Thailand in 2017, while Butters and Wright played in Indianapolis and Minneapolis as part of USA Volleyball's High Performance pipeline.

ALL-AMERICANS

Several players on the MSU roster can call themselves All-Americans at either the college or high school level. Senior Lily Johnson is a three-time AVCA Honorable Mention All-America selection during her time as a Bear, and she is joined by Sam Brinkmann, Aubrey Cheffey, Ashley Dudenhoeffer, Emelie Orlando, Veronica Snelling and Cambree Villarreal as players who earned the distinction during their prep careers.

SIX IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The number six has been a milestone number the last 19-plus seasons in terms of winning streaks, as the Bears have strung together at least six consecutive wins a total of 23 times since the beginning of the 1999 season. In fact, Missouri State has 75 separate streaks of at least six consecutive wins in its history, along with 21 double-figure streaks, with five of those coming during Stokes's tenure.

HOMECOMING

Missouri State has been dominant at home since 2000, compiling a record of 194-47 for an .805 winning percentage at Hammons Student Center.

The Bears are 7-2 in 2017 and have won at least 64 percent of their home matches in 17 consecutive seasons.

LOCAL FLAVOR

Missouri State boasts two players from Springfield on its 2017 roster (Brianna Dixon and Gerri Idos from Kickapoo High) and a total of seven players from southwest Missouri, including Lauren Boone (Branson), MacKenzie Irwin (Joplin), Laynie Dake (Mount Vernon), Ashley Ophoven (Ozark), and Aubrey Cheffey (Nixa). In all, 11 of MSU's 20 players hail from the Show-Me State.
